- 1. Men may live in a separate tent or cabin within the tent or cabin
- 2. Men may live in a separate room in the following lodges: Camp Cedarledge - Wohl, Manor House, Petite Chalet, Gail's Place; Camp Fiddlecreek - Sequoia; and Camp Tuckaho -Sacajawea.
- 3. If necessary, separate housing is also available: Camp Cedarledge - Commissary (not for winter troop camping), Staff House: Camp Fiddlecreek - Redwood Cabin; and Camp Tuckaho - Sugar Shack.

Please use Safety Activity Checkpoints and Girl Scouts of Eastern Missouri Policies and Standards to plan a safe program experience. Troops will be notified of placement via mail approximately two weeks after pull day.
