### Team Commitments:

- We agree:
  - We are an official Girl Scout Troop and are aware of Girl Scout troop requirements such as participating in the Girl Scout Cookie Program and Fall Product Program
  - Our team is required to participate in one FLL Jr. Exhibition, regardless of how far our team has progressed
  - All team equipment borrowed from Girl Scouts will be returned at the completion of the program. We will keep all equipment clean and in good condition for the duration of the program, and only use it for its intended purpose
  - We will participate in at least two outreach activities that will reach an additional 50 youth (examples include school presentations or neighborhood demonstrations), in order to share my team's accomplishments and the benefits of participating in robotics
  - Our team will be asked to volunteer at promotional events Girl Scouts hosts, and we will help as much as possible
  - We will clearly identify ourselves as Girl Scouts in any competitions, recruitment or media events and abide by Girl Scout troop guidelines if traveling outside of council boundaries

Adult Commitments:

  - We will provide at least one adult volunteer to help with one *FIRST* event (Expo or Qualifier)
  - Because we are a Girl Scout Troop, we will follow girl/adult ratios at all times. At least one adult present must be female and not related to the other adult

  - We will provide all paperwork by state deadlines, including but not limited to surveys, logs of time spent on the project, photo releases and photos by March 31, 2018
