GENERAL INFORMATION

Girl Scouts of Eastern Missouri provides financial aid for the purchase of age-appropriate uniforms to girls who qualify. Grants cover the purchase of a tunic or vest for Daisy level (K-1st), or a sash for all other girl levels (2nd - 12th). Uniform Assistance Fund grants include the core insignia items of the American Flag patch, GSEM Council ID patch set & troop numerals. Girls are eligible to receive one grant per age level and one grant within a membership year (October 1 – September 30). Duplicate/replacement uniforms will not be provided.

- Financial aid is available for girls who do not have the funds to buy the above referenced uniform pieces. Girl Scouts' no-discrimination policy applies to the awarding of all financial aid for uniforms.
- All details concerning financial aid requests are kept confidential.

ELIGIBILITY

- Uniform assistance is only available for girl members.
- Applicants must have an active Girl Scout membership with the Eastern Missouri Council and be assigned to an active troop to be considered for assistance.
- Applications must be signed by a parent/guardian.
- A "Statement of Need" describing the inability of the girl's parent/guardian to buy the uniform on their own must be included. Applications without a "Statement of Need" included will be rejected.
- Uniform assistance is non-transferable and valid only for the girl for whom a grant is awarded.
- Applicants and/or families with outstanding balances of any kind (not "No Funds Handling") are not eligible for uniform assistance until all open balances are paid in full.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

• Uniform assistance is awarded on an individual basis based on the "Statement of Need" submitted.
