Brownie Cybersecurity Basics

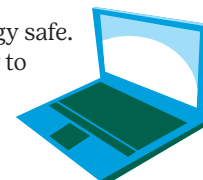

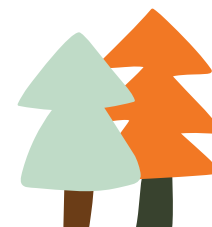

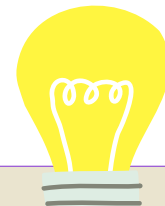
