



Your Impact on April Showers

For the last 25 years, our Girl Scouts along with their troops and families have worked together to collect personal care items for those in need in our communities. In partnership with Operation Food Search, these items are distributed to agencies across eastern Missouri.

Girl Scouts promote April Showers through distributing sticky notes door-to-door, doing in-person promotion at local stores and sharing online. The community has the opportunity to donate by leaving items on their porch for girls to pick up, donating at a store during Showering the Community, purchasing items for donation through one of our online registries or donating at a local Schnucks or Dierbergs Market through their in-store collection.

In 2023, with your generous support, we collected almost 1.3 million personal care items that have been distributed to more than 250 agencies across eastern Missouri.
