

Sample Kaper Chart

Kaper charts identify which individual, pair or small group is responsible for completing specific tasks, and are developed during the business part of the meeting. Kaper charts are a good way for girls to learn about the responsibilities of being in a troop. Every girl should participate in each activity on the chart at some point during the Girl Scout Year.
